The benefits out of the allotted assistance to the handicapped children

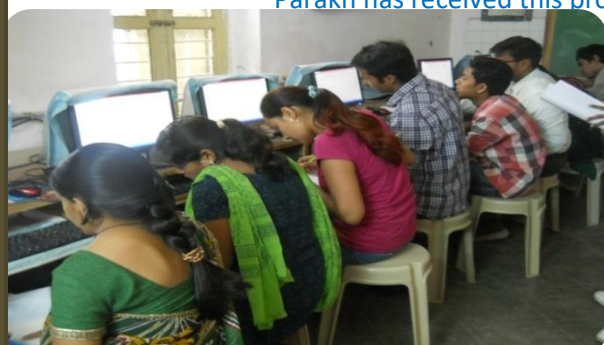
1. The physically handicapped child can acquire education with the help of tricycle, callipers, crutches properly and effectively .Apart from it children can deal with other children of their own area amicably.
