On 11/10/2020, a mentally weak woman referred by 181 Women's Helpline was given shelter at "Sakhi" One Stop Centre, Aravalli run by Parakh Trust, Himmatnagar.

With the coordination of all the staff and by medical treatment she was interrogated and told that she is from Adampur in Jalandhar district of Punjab. As per information given by Savarna we contacted the "Sakhi" One Stop Centre Jalandhar, They explored all the information about Savarna and find her family. With the help of Jalandhar OSC, we made a video call with his family and they were reported she have been out of the house for 6 months in lockdown but they

Could not come to pick up the victim in Gujarat due to his poor financial condition. Therefore with the help of Aravalli OSC Staff and Jalandhar OSC has been Rehabilitated Savarna with her family.

On 25/05/2020 at 9:00 pm, 181 women helpline gave shelter to an unstable brain victim at "Sakhi" One Stop Center, Aravalli run by Parakh Trust.

In which, after interrogating motiya's for 3 consecutive

days from the coordination of all the staff, she mentioned village named as khedulya and Lakshmipura. So that the names given by her searching on Google by Staff, shown from the state of Rajasthan. Then With help of ASI of Tok Police Station, he spoke to her on the phone with this information was sent to Sakhi One Stop Aravalli and her family was contacted through ASI of Tok Police Station.

Tok's ASI sent all the information as well as all the evidence of his identity and the missing report of motiya to OSC, Aravalli. Motiya's husband was called to the OSC, Aravalli on 30/05/2019 and after 21 months she was reunited with her family

Success Story of OSC Gandhinagar

Story: 1

Preliminary information of the case



Sheelaben Surya had left home about 2-3 months ago. She was found from Ramnagar village in Kalol taluka of Gandhinagar district and was contacted by the village sarpanch. Kalol police station personnel inquired about the sister in the surrounding villages but their information was not received. In addition, the sister is mentally unstable / mentally retarded and cannot provide even basic information about herself or her whereabouts. She was placed at Sakhi-One Stop Center by Kalol Police Station on 19/08/2020.

Success in reuniting the family of a mentally retarded / mentally retarded sister from Palasi village in Madhya Pradesh through the Government of India's Digital India program.

The sister was frequently counselled by the centre administrators on duty at Sakhi-One Stop Centre as well as the case worker. It was very difficult to get information with her as she was mentally unstable. In the beginning, the sister sometimes declared Bharuch as her abode, sometimes as "Palasi" and sometimes as "Kuksi". But it was more difficult to find out which district these villages are in by searching on Google than talking to them. Because the sister spoke Gujarati, Hindi as well as any of her local languages. The dress and appearance of the sister seemed to be on the Dahod-Godhra side. Finally, after the tireless efforts of the staff of the center, the information of Palasi and Kukshi villages mentioned by the sister was obtained with the help of Google Map. Also, due to the Digital India program of the Government of India, the Secretary (Talati) of Palasi village was contacted with the help of the website of the Rural Development Department of the State of Madhya Pradesh. At the same time, with the help of a friend, it was learned that the displaced people of Narmada Dam in the state of Madhya Pradesh live in 'Naveria Gram Panchayat' of Kalol taluka of Panchmahal district. With the help of Dilipbhai, a resident of this village and displaced from Palasi village in Madhya Pradesh state, it was found out that the sister is from Palasi village. After asking for the details of the sister's Aadhaar card, it was confirmed that the sister is a resident of Palasi village in the state of Madhya Pradesh. The sister also had a telephone conversation with her brother Prakashbhai. According to the conversation with her brother, the sister has been mentally unstable since childhood and this sister had left home twice before. According to his brother, his family's financial situation is not good and he cannot afford to treat his sister mentally. And since they are farming, no one can take care of them at home. So they reunite Sheila sister; Can't take home. Her brother requested Sakhi - One Stop Center, Gandhinagar to arrange

for Sheelabahen to be treated at a mental health hospital. So that under the guidance of District Women and Child Development Officer as well as Parakh Institute, Dat. Arrangements were made for the sister to get mental health treatment at "Jai Ambe Mandabuddhi Mahila Samaj Seva Trust, Bayad" in Aravalli district on 9/08/2018. The trust provides medical check-ups as well as medical treatment to mentally challenged persons by government as well as private doctors with all basic facilities. The organization also makes efforts to reunite such mentally challenged persons with their families as their mental condition improves.

Sakhi – Sheela bahen was given shelter for a total of 8 (eight) days at the One Stop Center and special care was taken by the centre as she is mentally retarded. He could not speak a single sentence and it was difficult to understand if he spoke. What a dumb person is saying would be true without even thinking about it. Only with guidance can it be possible to identify a sister and reunite her with her family. In addition, at the request of the family, the Sakhi-One Stop Center has also been successful in arranging for the treatment of the sister so that her mental health can improve quickly.

Preliminary information of the case;

Sujata Kumari Pradipkumar Sharma 121 Abhayam Helpline called Sakhi One Stop Center Gandhinagar and Adalaj Police Station transferred the woman to Sakhi One Stop Center Gandhinagar. From then on, her husband started harassing her for dowry and started threatening her for divorce. She was physically and mentally abused by her husband for dowry and was not even allowed to go to her pier. She was also mentally tortured by her husband for not having a child. She had been suffering from this for the last five years. But she was beaten unbearably by her husband and kicked out of the house and admitted to the hospital. Sujataben was shifted to Sakhi One Stop Center, Gandhinagar by the police as none of her relatives lived in Gujarat as her pier was in Jharkhand from the hospital.

Operation of Sakhi One Stop Center:

Sujataben was given four days shelter at Sakhi One Stop Center Gandhinagar and underwent medical treatment. With the help and guidance of Parakh Trust Himmatnagar, the organization which runs Sakhi One Stop Center Gandhinagar, Sujataben was appointed on temporary basis as a social worker under Gujarat Livelihood Promotion Urban Livelihood Mission Scheme. Sujataben was arranged by Sakhi One Stop Center to stay in Working Woman in Lockdown.

Follow up:

Sujataben is currently at her husband's house rather than a telephonic follow-up and is currently being treated well by her in-laws. Sujatamben thanked Sakhi One Stop Center and its staff and Parakh Institute.
