On 12/10/2021, a woman referred by 181 Women Helpline affected by domestic violence has been given shelter at Sakhi One Stop Center, Aravalli, run by Parakh Trust.

During the 2 years of their marriage, she had a son who died after birth due to his death their in-laws started physically and mentally torturing her. On 12/10/2021, she left home and reached Malpur after being harassed by her husband and her father-in-law came to search for her in Malpur. For her self-defense she called 181 Women Helpline and Team 181 brought her to the Sakhi One Stop Center and sheltered her. She was given 7 days shelter at Sakhi One Stop Center. And she, who underwent medical checkup, underwent necessary treatment and was informed, is 2 months pregnant. She has been rehabilitated after counseling her husband and in-laws.

Artiben Suthar Asar got married 9 months ago of his own free will through a love relationship without the permission of his parents and with the permission of his in-laws. As Artiben's husband and mother-in-law were mentally and physically torturing her, she was spending her time doing private jobs. As the mother-in-law and husband refused to work, Artiben asked them to continue working, so the husband and mother-in-law left the house without a ticket as they were physically injured. Artiben sought help from both parties to make a compromise.

Artiben was given shelter for 2 days at Sakhi One Stop Center Gandhinagar and was given medical treatment. With the guidance and help of Parakh Trust Himmatnagar, the organization managing Sakhi One Stop Center Gandhinagar, the families of both sides of Artiben were called to the center for counseling and amicable settlement was made and they were consulted to get a job.
