They were seen roaming in the area of Gajan toll tax and reported to 181 women helpline by a vigilant citizen. 181 team put them here for shelter. Interventions by "Sakhi" One Stop Center:

Ben was given medical treatment at Civil Hospital Himmatnagar by the staff of Sakhi One Stop Center and counseled as his mental condition improved and it was learned that he is a native of Navsari. So the police station there was contacted and Sakhi One Stop Center Navsari was searched for his family but as the financial condition of his family was not good, OSC's vehicle was seized by the police and resettled with his family at Sakhi One Stop Center Navsari.

were sent to Gandhinagar Centre.

While counseling Radhaben, it was found that she is mentally ill, by looking at her language and dress, it was found that she is from Bihar, with the help of Lakhisarai police station in Bihar, her family was traced and after contacting her family, her husband was called to OSC Gandhinagar, as her son is mentally ill. Also, since his financial condition was not good, he could not come to OSC Gandhinagar in Gujarat, so he was called to OSC in Lakhisarai and re-established Radhaben by 2employees of OSC Gandhinagar.

- To Give Admission in his nearest School (Primary/Secondary/higher Secondary)
- To give benefit by Govt Schemes to every disabled.

1. The physically handicapped child can acquire education with the help of tricycle, callipers, crutches properly and effectively. Apart from it children can deal with other children of their own area amicably
2. The help of M.R. Educational kit enhances the interest of learning among the children. The pragmatic training received by the children and the knowledge obtained thereby facilitate the children to achieve mental and physical development through effective expression. The help of hearing aid and educational kit develop in the hearing-impaired child the hearing capacity. The hearing impaired child bails out of the inferiority complex of deafness by getting acquainted with the sounds of the surroundings and developing concepts with the average children with the help of hearing-aid
